

## **Parish to apply to Fingal County Council for Planning Permission for proposed Parish Pastoral Centre in Howth**

Following a public display in the Church over a three-week period of the design of the proposed Parish Pastoral Centre to be located in the Church ground site, the Parish's consultants have been preparing the detailed engineering, architectural and design requirements for a Planning Application to Fingal County Council.

In the meantime, the design remains posted on the Parish website [www.howthparish.ie](http://www.howthparish.ie) to be viewed at any time by all interested parties.

A Statutory Notice of intent to apply for Planning Permission will be posted in the Church grounds and in a newspaper as is required during the week commencing Monday 12<sup>th</sup> December 2022.

Following lodgement of the Planning Application with Fingal County Council, the detailed documentation and drawings will become available to view at [www.fingal.ie/view-or-search-planning-applications](http://www.fingal.ie/view-or-search-planning-applications) or by calling to the Fingal County Offices in Swords.

Parishioners will be advised of the Council's decision in due course. As previously signalled, receipt of Planning Permission is but one of a number of steps required to determine if the project can proceed to construction.
