Guest Speaker: Catherine Leyden at Sunday Mass

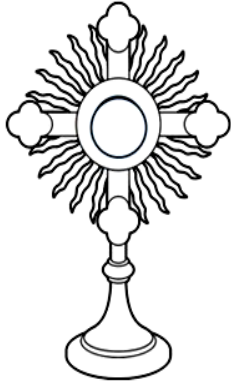
11th May 12:30 pm in St. Fintan's Church, Sutton.

REFLECTIONS

Third Sunday of Easter.

4th MAY 2025

'It is the Lord!' The beloved disciple recognises the friendly and helpful man at the lakeside. As of yet it had not dawned on Simon Peter or the others who it is. 'It is the Lord!' Yes, words of recognition, but much more: seeing with eyes of faith. His recognition spurs on the others to recognise the risen Jesus with eyes of faith.

Aren't there moments in times of need when help seems to come from an unexpected source and we sense the presence of the Lord. The unexpected catch of fish was such a moment for the disciples. Pray for light to recognise such a moment in the recent past.

'Come and have breakfast.' A homely invitation!. Jesus knew the hunger of these men after a night's fishing. He knows our needs too. Tell the risen Jesus of your rights now, Wait quietly to receive Jesus' to be linger in his presence as he looks at you with a smile of affection.
